

Actions Taken

- The IFC is delighted to hear that the IFC Operating Collaboration Fund Working Agreement is in the final signature stages and looks forward to completion of the signature process by the end of April.
- The DOE and SLAC reiterated their strong support for GLAST and emphasized that it is an extremely important element of their future program.
- NASA reiterated that, despite very difficult budgets, GLAST remains a high priority program and is being fully supported.
- The IFC was pleased to see the continuing and productive strong interplay between the particle astrophysics and particle physics cultures that has developed in GLAST.
- The IFC recognized the importance of a strong, focused multi-wavelength observing campaign to augment GLAST observations and optimize the science return from the mission. The IFC looks forward to updates on the collaboration's multi-wavelength plans at future meetings.
- The IFC acknowledged the importance of the international partnerships that have been essential to the success of the construction of the LAT.
- The IFC appreciated the excellent presentation on the GLAST EPO efforts by Dr. Lynn Cominsky. Her team is doing excellent work and we all will benefit from her efforts.
- Pending agreement from the absent INFN and ASI representatives, and pending the completion of the OCF working agreement signature process, the CY06 budget presented by the PI was approved.
- The CY07 budget presented by the PI was discussed.
- The excellent presentations on the ISOC were appreciated and the IFC was delighted to hear of the progress in the ISOC development since their last meeting.
- The IFC recognized the importance of the DC2 effort for the collaboration and was impressed with its implementation.
- The progress on the beam test is impressive and the IFC looks forward to hearing the results at a future meeting.
- The IFC was very grateful for the offer from the IN2P3 and CEA representatives to host the next IFC meeting. The next GLAST IFC meeting is tentatively scheduled for September 4/5 in Paris. The backup date is Sunday October 8 at SLAC. The date will be finalized by the IFC Chair by the end of March.
